The successful candidate may be called upon to assist with the investigation or resolution of public health or environmental problems. Functions as a resource on building and construction codes and requirements related to health care facilities, assists in tracking status of Health Care Engineering (HCE) staff projects, assists with preparing presentations for HCE, and serves as the designated team leader in the absence of the Program Director.

The qualified candidate should possess at least a bachelor's degree from an accredited college (major in Engineering required) plus six (6) years engineering experience. License to practice Engineering in the State of Indiana or accredited graduate training in Engineering may be considered in place of the required years of experience. (Proof of licensure must accompany application.)
